EDT 110 and EDT 110L The Profession of Teaching and Lab, is required by the University of Dayton to be successfully completed by all students in the Department of Teacher Education. For current Sinclair students accepted into the UD-Sinclair Academy, this course may be taken at the University of Dayton, at no cost to the student, while still taking classes at Sinclair. The University of Dayton advisors can provide information regarding eligibility and registration. We strongly encourage Academy students to take EDT 110 and Lab at the University of Dayton prior to transitioning to the University of Dayton.
