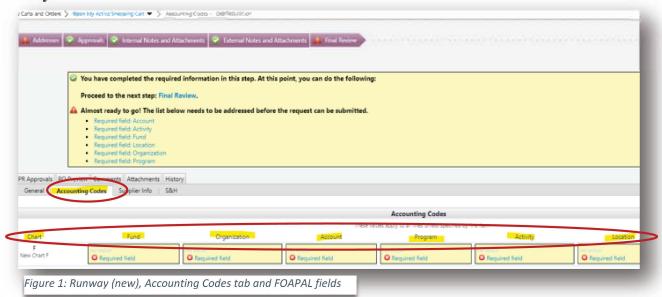

ACCOUNTING CODE FAVORITES

Accounting indexes will no longer be used in Runway. The entire FOAPAL string will now be required. Figure 1 (below) shows a snapshot of the updated "Accounting Codes" section with a Runway cart.



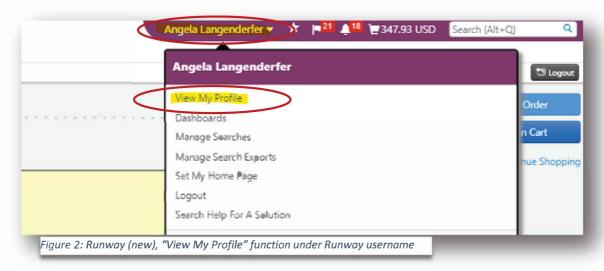
CREATING ACCOUNTING CODE FAVORITES

Instead of typing in entire FOAPAL strings for any Runway purchase, users may wish to save strings for later purchases and have them auto-populate. The following pictures will explain how.

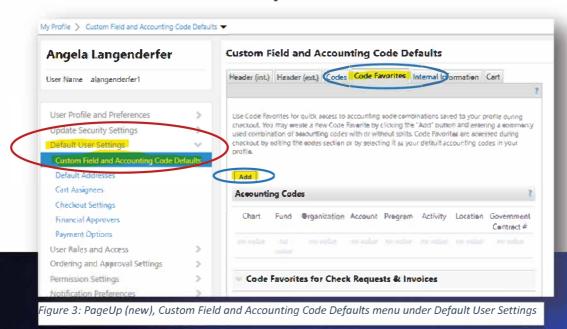

Users will select View My Profile (Figure 2, below) under the same username dropdown in the upper right-hand corner of the Runway page.



Within the View My Profile page, users will select Default User Settings, then Custom Field and Accounting Code Defaults (Figure 3, in red). Under the Code Favorites tab, select Add to begin creating an accounting code favorite (Figure 3, in blue). There is no need to create a code favorite under "Code Favorites for Check Requests & Invoices".

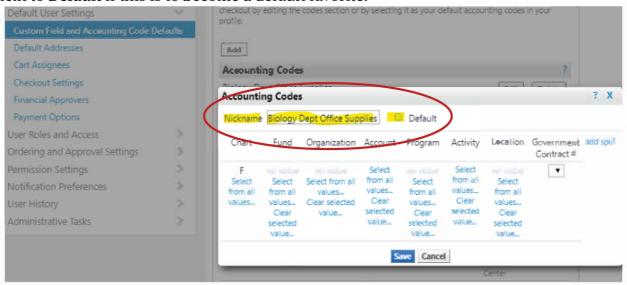


Figure 4: Runway (new), Nickname field and Default option checkbox

The user should create a Nickname (Figure 4, below) that will help them to identify it for repetitive use of the accounting string favorite (e.g. Biology Dept. Office Supplies). The user should check the box next to **Default** if this is to become a default favorite.

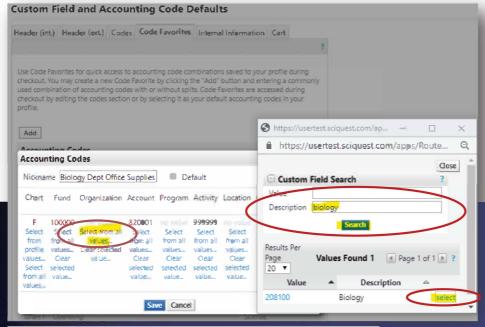


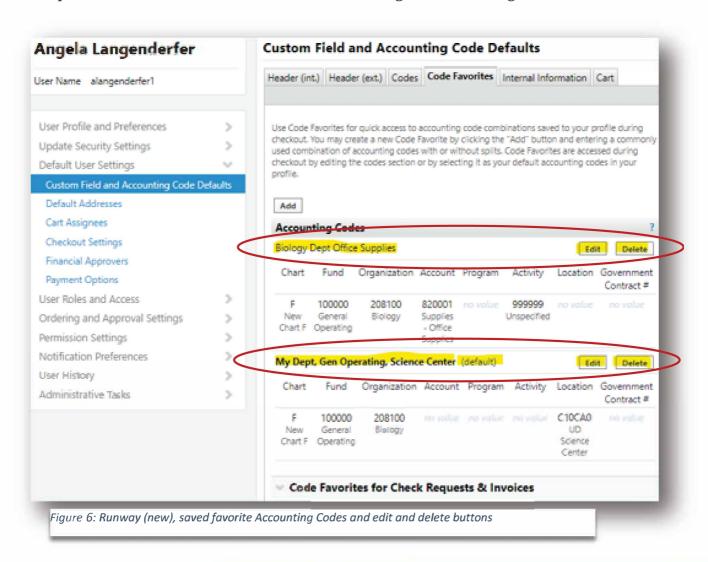
Figure 5: Runway (new), Select from all values and Custom Field Search/ select

Next, in the blue links under the Chart, Fund, Organization, Account, Program, Activity & Location headings, the user should choose "Select from all values" (Figure 5, below) link and enter a description or value, "Search", and then choose "select". In this example, Program and Location will not be included because the user anticipates these values changing often.

After specific accounting codes are added, select "save". The new code favorite will be displayed, along with an option to "edit" or "delete". Multiple code favorites can be created with various combinations. It is recommended that any code favorite default is created with at least one blank value to prevent cart submission without users reviewing the Accounting Codes section.

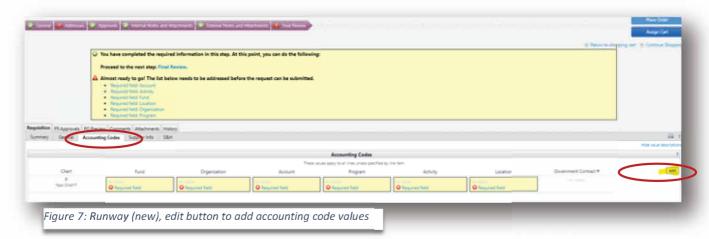

The next time a cart is created the code favorites will be available. Within the "Accounting Codes" section of the cart, select "edit" to add the accounting codes values.



Select the nicknamed favorite from the dropdown within the "Select from your code favorites" box. The accounting code values will systematically populate. If necessary, add or correct any missing accounting and "save".
